## **Chapter activities**

The Queensland Chapter of the ASPG welcomed a new Chair, Mr David Fraser, from 4 September 2017.

In Queensland there was a dissolution of the parliament for the 2017 state election, which occurred on 25 November 2017.

Following the state election, the Chapter embarked on a recruitment and membership campaign consisting of formal introductions to all MPs of the parliament, and a welcome presentation to new MPs during their induction program in 2018.
