



## **STOP late-term ABORTION**

Do you know? Labor supports: abortion up to birth for any reason\*

with NO safeguards for pregnant women\* Labor plans extreme new abortion laws if it wins the Queensland state election\* LNP leader Tim Nicholls has promised in writing that the LNP will not support any change to the abortion laws in the next term of Parliament.

Labor introduced extreme abortion laws in Victoria (2008) and Tasmania (2013) that permit abortion for any reason up to birth. These laws include no requirement for independent courselling, and no cooling-off periods.
